Class Descriptions



Chinese Dance

Each week, students will learn a different style of Chinese dance from the diverse regions and indigenous ethnic groups of China such as handkerchief dance from Northeast China, Mongolian chopstick dance, or Dai dance. Through dance, students will learn about different customs and ways of life prevalent to the peoples of China.

Speak in Mandarin during this class which uses images, songs, games and other playful activities to teach the basics of conversation, reading and writing. A different set of vocabulary and sentence structures are covered each week. Instructors from the other classes may supplement this class by speaking to students in Mandarin.



Singing

This course is intended for students with little or no background in music who would like to develop a theoretical and practical understanding of how music works and learn the fundamentals of singing. Students will be introduced to different kinds of musical notation, melodic systems, harmonies, meters, and rhythmic techniques. They will also learn the fundamentals of singing like breathing, posture, and diction. These basic principles are key to strong vocal performances. The instructor will guide beginner singers through the early stages of vocal progression, assisting with pitch training, developing timbre and keeping a steady tempo. Our core philosophy is that the best way for students to gain musical proficiency is through performance-based activities.

Students will learn basic traditional Chinese-inspired painting techniques. These crafts help develop fine motor skills, hand-eye coordination, and spatial reasoning.



Kung Fu

Learn basic stances, strikes, and techniques, while boosting coordination and stamina, developing quick reflexes, mental concentration, and building self-esteem.

Students will explore a range of crafts, including 3D paper crafts and painting. Students will learn how to construct paper lanterns, pencil holders, and picture frames.



Musical Theater

This course is intended for students with little or no background in music who want to improve their music skills on singing and appreciation ability. Students will learn different kinds of musical notation, melodic systems, harmonies, meters, and rhythmic techniques. Students will learn basic vocal skills. They will have a chance to appreciate some musical movies. The instructor will focus on Broadway songs and give some special training on lyrics and pitch. Students will build their musical proficiency in this class.
